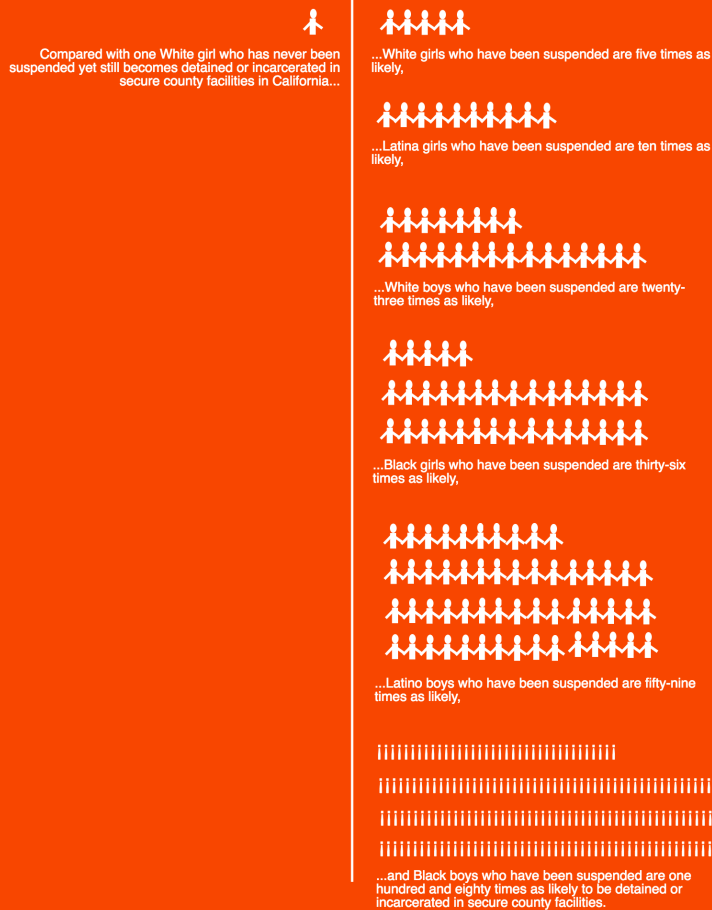


The Path From School Suspensions to Youth Incarceration in California
